Birds of Jirdarup:

- ✿ 'Jirdarup' means 'Place of Birds'. To celebrate National Bird Week, **expert guides from Birdlife Western Australia** will lead an early morning Bushland walk.
- ✿ Expect to learn about and see some of the 50 species of fabulous native birds that visit the Bushland, including:
 - Carnaby's black cockatoo
 - Forest Red-Tailed Black Cockatoo
 - Rainbow Bee-eater (which nests in burrows!)
 - New Holland Honeyeater
 - Black-faced Cuckoo-shrike
 - Western Spinebill
- ✿ Bring water, hat and binoculars
- ✿ Duration 1½ hours
- ✿ Gold coin donations appreciated.
- ✿ Morning tea provided after the walk.
- ✿ Level pathway throughout.
- ✿ Toilets nearby.
