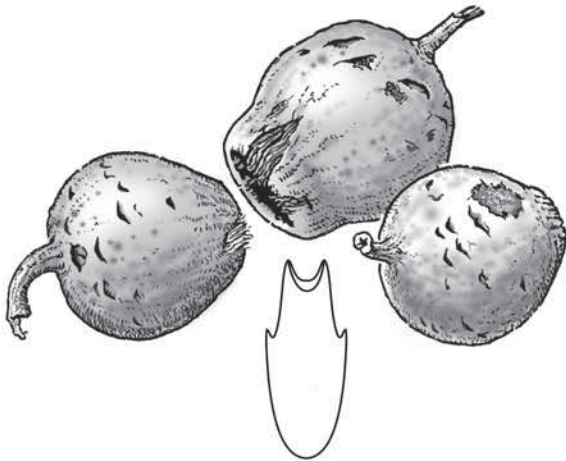
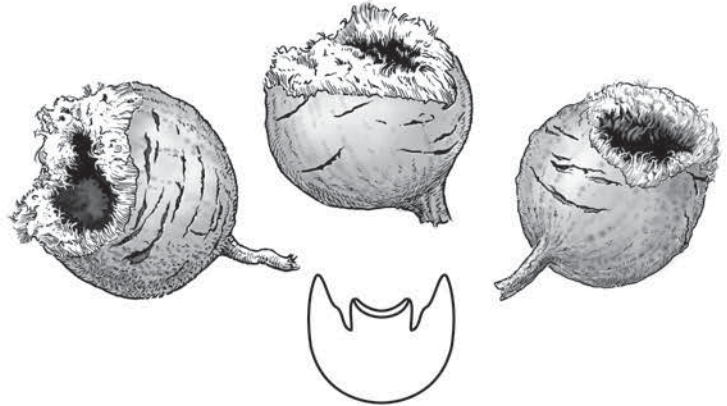


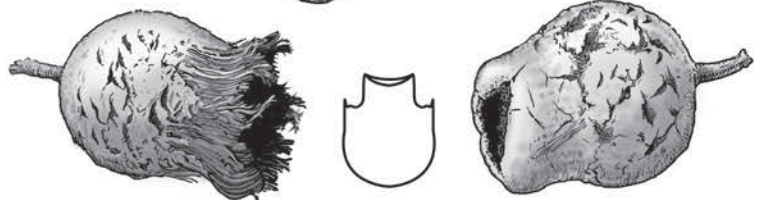
Identification of chewed Marri nuts eaten by cockatoos and parrots with an end-on view of lower mandible of each species



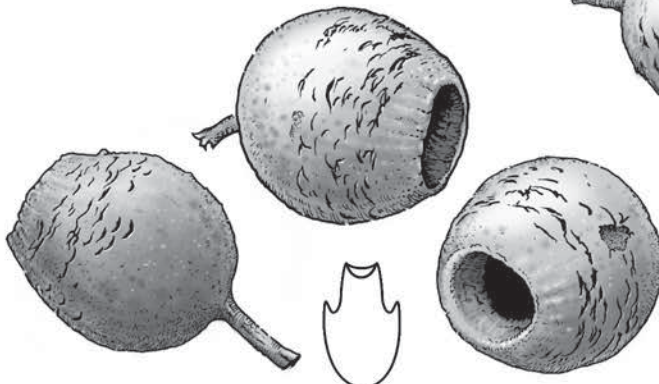
Baudin's Cockatoo



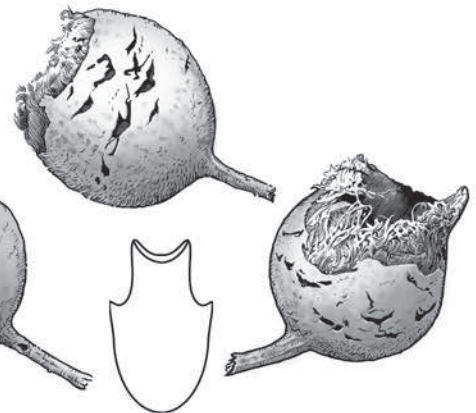
Forest Red-tailed Black Cockatoo



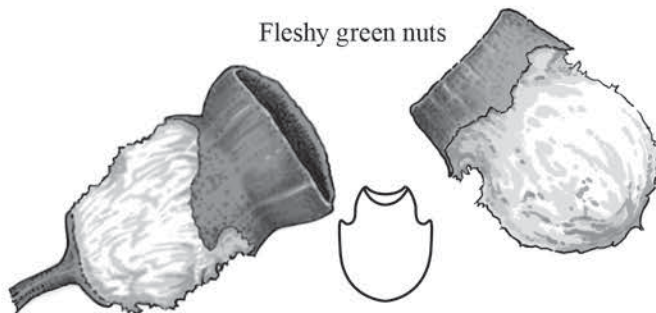
